"ARE YOU 'DRIVEN' OR 'CALLED'?"

In his book entitled Ordering Your Private World, Gordon MacDonald discusses people who are either "driven" or "called." At first glance, the two seem harmless. After a deeper look it is clear that a driven person is one who is:

- Always result oriented
- Constantly trying to be greater
- Restless and intense
- Extremely competitive
- A person with poor people skills
- Too busy to be a person of integrity
- Preoccupied with symbols of self-achievement
- Often characterized by outbursts of anger

In most cases it is true that such people never find true peace. After reading that list, I am ready to find out what it means to be a "called person" aren't you? Called people generally:

- Are happy to be stewards of another's property
- Are satisfied in knowing who they are, even if that means not being "number one"
- Have an unshakeable confidence in their mission
- Are committed to their task

In the past weeks, we have looked at several aspects of the life of King Saul. He was a driven person. He was driven by ego, by power and by the attention he desired from others. When push came to shove, he was ready to disobey God in order to further his own "agenda."

To find a truly "called" person, I would look to John the Baptist. We read such statements as: "**A person can only receive what is given them from heaven;**" "**He must increase but I must decrease.**" (**John 3:27, 30**). John was fully confident, satisfied and committed to his function as one who prepared the way for something greater, for someone greater. He knew his purpose, he knew his calling, and he knew the one who had called him!

Our world puts a lot of stock in being driven. Looking around, I don't find many who have the calm and peaceful assurance that they are where they need to be. In the case of believers, how many of us are good stewards of what God has given? Can we stand confidently and committedly before God, allowing him to use us for his purposes and as he sees fit?

"The fruit of that righteousness will be peace; its effect will be quietness and confidence forever." **Isaiah 32:17**
