"WITH THANKSGIVING"

I was recently reminded of a biblical lesson by my ten year old daughter. I had spent all day doing manual labor around the house and my arm started to hurt. Three years ago, while changing the tire on the BHCC fifteen-passenger van, it rolled off the jack and pinned my arm between the spare tire and the hitch of the van. Even though it was extremely flattened and damaged, amazingly nothing was broken and I only had a single puncture wound. If I had managed to pull the tire out another inch or two before it fell, I might have lost my arm.

So, as I sat there complaining about my arm, my daughter reminded me, "At least you still have an arm to hurt." In one quick little witty comment my daughter put things into perspective. It is so easy when things aren't going our way to forget to be grateful for the things we have been given. We are told "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7) We often remember the part about not being anxious and sending our request to God, but then we forget about the part where we are suppose do all things with thanksgiving. I believe in that perspective, and I love a caring God that allows us to have that peace that passes all understanding.

I don't know about you, but I think our world could use a little bit of that peace these days. We may not be able to fix things that are going on, but we can live lives that point people in the direction of the One who can. So, the next time we find ourselves being anxious or worried, we should start counting our blessings and let God know what is going on. And let us "... Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have". (1 Peter 3:15).
