## Grasping Grace, Sharing Grace

Our recent studies in the letter of Galatians have opened my mind to the wonder of God's grace. Grasping the magnificent grace of God is a lifelong process of discovery and acceptance! Understanding what it means to be freed from sin by that grace, should enable us to experience the freedom to share that grace with others with whom we come into contact. The following are thoughts by Jon Walker, author of a book entitled, Costly Grace.

> We see this in John 4, when Jesus meets the woman at the well. When she offers to give him a drink, he says, 'If you knew the generosity of God and who I am, you would be asking me for a drink, and I would give you fresh living water' (John 4:10 MSG).

Note that he talks about how gracious God can be. Yet most of us, if we were gut honest, function as if God were stingy with his grace. We fear his punishment, in the sense that we think he's the high school principal walking the halls, taking down names. Who did what and who's to blame? But God already knows who did what and who's to blame, and he still loves us anyway. His interest is in redeeming us, not in keeping us on the hook for our sins. Unfortunately, many of us—Christians—live our lives as if we're still on the hook, and as if we have to keep everyone else on the hook. We use weapons of the flesh—the sarcastic comment, the angry stare—all designed to get people to straighten up and live right. In contrast, when the woman at the well goes back to her village, she says, 'Come see a man . . . who knows me inside and out' (John 4:29 MSG). Nothing is hidden from him, and vet he communicates with her in such a fashion that she leaves feeling loved and accepted. That's the aroma of grace. (Walker, pp. 31-32)
