"MY SHEEP HEAR MY VOICE ..."

Years ago, a Christian brother gave me a small poster for a birthday present. The picture showed a "herd" (actually it would be a "waddle") of penguins lined up on the top of a sheer ice-cliff. The "leader" of the herd had already jumped and the rest were following him, leaping off the cliff into the icv waters. A comical depiction at best, but a good description of the "herd mentality" that we so often see around us. Crowds form around small groups or individuals, who are often those determined to push their own motives and agendas. Before you know it, a mob has formed. Listening to those individuals who speak the loudest, protesters – often peaceful protesters – are transformed into rioters, and in the process, laws are broken, stores are looted, cars are burned, property and even lives are destroyed.

It seems that as a society, we have become increasingly polarized and tribal. We tend to rally behind ideas, movements or even people. The tendency is there to look down on those who think differently than we do. We humans seem to have a tendency toward the "herd" or "mob-mentality" don't we? I guess Jesus knew us well when he called us "sheep!" Whether it is following certain trends online, or actually participating in open protests, we would do well to first remember the words of Paul in Ephesians 4:29, "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."

We should also continually reconsider the voices we listen to and believe. Are we listening to the voices of the crowd? Are we easily swept away by "fine sounding arguments" that tend to pull us into one direction or the other? Are we listening first and foremost to the voice of our Shepherd? It is so important for us as Christ-followers to remember who we are following and tune our ears to "hear his voice" and follow him only.
