WALK BY FAITH, NOT BY SIGHT

I woke the other day just to find out that my eyes were so agitated by allergies that I could not put in my contacts. I went to find my back up glasses only to be reminded that my almost 2-year-old had found them the other day and destroyed them. I had to spend the morning stumbling around not being able to see. Without corrective lenses, I lose most of my depth perception and everything just looks like blurry blobs. As the morning went on, I gave up relying on what I could see and just started feeling for things where I knew they should be.

It is hard not to rely on what we see. That is why Paul told the church in Corinth not to put their confidence in the earthly bodies we see, but in God, His Spirit, and His Resurrection. "For we walk by faith, not by sight." 2 Corinthians 5:7. I cannot help but be reminded of the story I wrote about recently of Elisha (it is one of my favorites). When Elisha and his servant got up in the morning, they found themselves surround by the enemy's army. The servant was panicked not knowing what to do, but Elisha remained calm. The servant ran to Elisha, "Oh no, my lord! What shall we do?" Elisha told him to relax. "Those who are with us are more than those who are with them." Then God opened the servant's eyes, and he "saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha." Elisha was able to see and understand that as long as he was with God, he had nothing to worry about. (2 Kings 6:15-17)

It is easy to look out around our world today and feel defeated. I know there are times that I need to be reminded to trust what I know and not necessarily what I can see. My prayer for us as followers of Christ is that we don't get too frustrated, defeated, or scared by what we see, but instead we reach out take hold of God's hand and walk by the faith we have in Him.
