THE UNTOUCHABLES OF **TODAY**

How do we, as Christians, handle the "untouchable issues" of today? How do we handle the pitfalls of our culture in our society today and still maintain our Christian principles? The answer is that we look to Jesus as our example. Jesus did not let the social status or cultural norms dictate his relationship with people.

In Mark 1:40-45, we see Jesus approached by someone labeled "untouchable" in his day because of disease. He was approached by a leper who sought Jesus' healing power, and Jesus healed him by touching him. He did not turn away but had the courage to turn and face him. This man was literally untouchable. Jesus reached out to him with his life and God's grace.

In Jesus' day, Rabbis and other spiritual leaders enjoyed widespread respect and were held in high esteem in Jewish society. The religious sect did not associate with those who chose not to follow their system of rules and thus were labeled as sinners and "untouchables". However, Jesus chose to associate with those who were labeled as outcasts and unworthy of respect because they needed his salvation.

Jesus came to save sinners. Jesus saw individuals, not labels, and sought to meet the needs around him. Traditions, cultural bans, and the frowns of the society at large, do not matter when the souls of men are at risk. In John 3:17, we are told that Jesus was sent to save the world.

A life lived in accordance to God's will leaves a mark on those whom we contact. A righteous life is a powerful thing. In Peter 2:12, we read, "...having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works which they observe, glorify God in this day of visitation." Is there not courage and power in this statement! If we are obedient to God's will, we should be brave as we approach the world's "untouchable" issues.

We must consider how Jesus acted as our example. What are the "untouchable" issues in our day? Are we as a church willing and equipped to handle them? Do we pray for opportunity to bring God's light to our world?
