BUT GOD CAN'T USE ME, CAN HE?

Most all of us have felt that God can't use us, haven't we? We do not seem to be able to nail down our purpose and we can't seem to find that "niche" where we really belong, or where we really feel productive and useful. Some people search their entire lives and never really find it. I was drawn to the words of Esther as she pondered what she should do with her life. Do you remember the story? The lowly Jewish girl who was chosen to become a queen. It was unknown to the king and to those around him that she was a Jew. She decided in the beginning that she would keep her family background and nationality a secret (2:20). But when it came to her attention that there was a plot brewing to annihilate her people, she struggled with what to do. When she was approached to use her position to help save her people, her first response was **"I haven't been called to go to the king."** She did not feel it was her task and it was dangerous to approach the king. After all, what could she do as a young queen? Mordecai, her uncle tells her that **her position as queen, and her privilege was her calling.** Remember those words, **"And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?"**

Who knows? To be honest, God knows. God has chosen you. God has placed you where you are, at this particular time and place for a specific purpose. He does not expect grand and elaborate plans. What he does want from us is the realization of who he is, what he has done for us and the willingness to use our gifts, our position, and our privilege for good and to his glory. You have been placed here **"for such a time as this."** What can you do, how can you use what you have, to bring God glory? Esther's story reminds me of the words of Stephen Grellet:

I shall pass through this world but once. Any good therefore that I can do or any kindness that I can show to any human being, let me do it now. Let me not defer or neglect it, for I shall not pass this way again.
