GOOD MORNING,

We had been working on finishing one of the rooms in our house so my son could have his own room again. When we moved him out of his old room, we put some of his toys in the back for storage, because there was just not room for them all. We have gotten to point of bringing those toys back out and he has had the best time rediscovering and playing with the toys. Some he had even forgotten that he had.

This reminded me of the situation in 2 Kings 22 when Josiah was king. He had been king for 18 years when he noticed the temple needed some repair. He sent the secretary to get the work started and we are told they found the book of the law as they were repairing the temple. Can you imagine? Things had gotten so bad that they lost God's Word. Most likely they are referring to the Torah, the first five books of the Bible. When the book was read aloud to Josiah, he realized it was not only the temple that had fallen into disrepair, but the nation of Judah had forgotten what it meant to serve the Lord. Josiah cleaned house – getting rid of all the altars to false gods – and they started celebrating the Passover again. In fact, in 2 Kings 23:25 it is said of Josiah,

Neither before nor after Josiah was there a king like him who turned to the LORD as he did—with all his heart and with all his soul and with all his strength, in accordance with all the Law of Moses.

We always need to make sure our lives have not gotten so busy or so focused on the problems that we have forgotten or misplaced God's word in our lives. There are many in the world today who feel in disrepair or directionless. The answer is the same as it was for the nation of Judah. We need to rediscover God's word and put it into practice. So, let us not be one of those people whose Bibles sit up on a shelf gathering dust instead of being read, memorized and, most importantly, put into practice.
