DREAMING THE POSSIBLE DREAM

Do you remember those dreams that cause you to sit on the side of the bed and wonder what that was all about? Most of us can remember dreams that troubled us, dreams that made us laugh or dreams that brought us into utter confusion. Psalm 126 talks about dreamers. No, it is not talking about the funny dreams we have at night, but about the feeling of utter joy that makes us want to pinch ourselves and ask if it is really happening. Returning to their homeland after having been in captivity, the Jewish pilgrims reveled in what God had done for them. **“The Lord has done great things for us and we are filled with joy!” Or “We were like those who dreamed.”**

This little Psalm, a song of ascent, speaks of another kind of “dreaming.” It speaks of the dreaming that is involved in sowing seed. A farmer “dreams” of the harvest that will come if he can get out and sow the seed. Great things can come if he will make the effort and if he trusts the “Lord of harvest.”

So, this Psalm encourages us to dream. It encourages us to look closely at all God has done and is doing for us and with us. We are such a blessed people! Sometimes I just need to stop and consider what it means to be a child of God, redeemed from the slavery of sin, blessed with a Christian family, and blessed with the hope of spending an eternity with the God who loves me! But dreaming does not stop there! We also dream when we take those blessings and invest them in the future of the church or when we invest them in the lives of others. Like that farmer planting his seed, we invest what God has blessed us with because we believe that there will be a harvest.

“Those who go out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with them.” Psalm 126:6
