# **GOOD MORNING**

After my lesson last week on expectations, I thought I would share this morning a sermon illustration I have heard several times. There is a "Dear Abby" letter about a young man from a famous family who was about to graduate from high school. It was a custom in the rich neighborhood where the young man grew up that parents bought their children a car upon graduation. The father and son spent the whole week before graduation looking for the perfect car. The young man was certain that the car would be his on the day of his graduation. Imagine the son's disappointment when instead of the keys to a brand-new car, his father handed him a gift-wrapped Bible. The son was so angry that he threw the Bible down and walked out of the house. He never saw his father alive again. The son returned home for his father's funeral, and upon going through his father's things he came across the Bible he was given on his graduation day. He dusted it off and opened it and inside he found a check – dated the day of his graduation – in the exact amount of the car his father and he had picked out together.

It a very sad story, but I think sometimes we do the same thing. You see, our heavenly Father has promised that He would give us good gifts if we ask (Matthew 7:11). Sometimes I think we turn God's gifts away – or refuse to recognize them as gifts – because of the packaging they come in. How many times have you been blessed by something that original appeared to be a trial or a hardship?

So, let us always be looking for the good gifts God gives and let us always remember that God knows what is best and has our best intentions at heart. So, do not turn a good gift away because you do not like the way it is packaged.
