# **GOOD MORNING**

As we were taking snow pictures (it snows so little here you must take pictures) I was explaining to my daughter about the idea of forced perspective. It the concept that people will use in photography, typically to make something appear larger or smaller than it really is. This happens a lot when fishermen hold their catch closer to the camera to make it look bigger compared to their body. I was showing her how, by using forced perspective, you can make you average sized snowman look like a monster or your half-built snow fort look like a palace.

Understanding perspective is important when it comes to photography, but it is also important when it comes to handling life's problems and situations. too. The things right in front of you will sometimes appear bigger and more important than they really are. Our problems can seem more than we can handle, but as followers of Christ we know that is not true, even if it feels like it sometimes. The prophet Isaiah tried to align his audience's perspective by asking questions: "Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?" (40:12).

God is so much bigger than any problem you could face. As we grow closer to him those problem begin to seem smaller and smaller. So, in a world that can seem overwhelmed with problems let us draw closer to God so that we can keep all things in perspective. And let us remember that the Lord "gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength" (Isaiah 40:29).
