"THE MOST EXCELLENT WAY."

Often, I long for the simplicity of Robert Frost's epic words, **"Two roads diverged in a yellow wood."** Two simple paths, two simple choices, and two directions . . . it seems like such a simple quandary to be in. Our world today seems so confusing in contrast to that simplicity. The choices seem so very complicated. What is the right way? What is the right choice?

In a polarized, conflicted, and charged environment, even faithful Christ-followers find themselves facing difficult choices. Many of those are brought about by conflicting information choices, fed by truths, half truths and down-right lies that are all thrown into one big pot. What shall I believe about the pandemic? Shall I receive the vaccination or not? Shall I wear a mask or not? These seemingly simple decisions have become a complicated quagmire of opinion. We all know what kind of effect this can have on the family of God.

It is in times like these where God's people can shine in a particularly confused world. How will we deal with one another during such times? How will we maintain our all-so-important unity when there seems to be so much to disagree about? How will we treat each other and our world during turbulent times? Paul confronts a group of believers who found more than enough to disagree on...and says **(1 Cor. 12:31) ". . . I will show you the most excellent way."** We can read on and find that the **"most excellent way"** is none other than the way of love. Earlier, in **8:1** he said, **"But knowledge puffs up while love builds up."**

So, there it is in a nutshell. We are called by God to be people who love. We love one another in the family of God. We love our neighbors. We love our world. We love because he has shown us what love can do. Love sacrifices. Love unifies. Love protects. We love because it is the **"most excellent way."**

Frost finishes his poem with the words, **"Two roads diverged in a wood, and I—I took the one less traveled by, and that has made all the difference."**

Will we choose the way that really can make a difference, **the most excellent way**, the way of love?
