GO INTO ALL THE WORLD

"Mark 16:15." An immigration officer said that to me when I checked in at the airport in Johannesburg. My immediate response was "Go into all the world and preach the gospel unto every creature." At first, I wasn't sure why he said that. Then I realized it was embroidered on my shirt. Jesus issued this command just before he ascended into heaven. Are we following His command today? How do we take the gospel to the world when everything is shut down? One way is by utilizing the tools of World Bible School.

World Bible School started as a correspondence course, with an ad in a Nigerian newspaper. Millions of students world-wide are registering for postal lessons every year. While Baker Heights isn't sending lessons overseas, we do send out many lessons to students here in the US.

Students and study helpers both utilize the website, www.worldbibleschool.org. Web students read the lessons and answer the questions online. After they complete a quiz, their Study Helper grades it and provides feedback. Communication is all done through the website. Many thousands of students prefer to study this way since they get their lessons right away. Students are able to complete courses in a fraction of the time it takes to mail and receive postal lessons.

A student LiteApp was launched in January. Students who have Android phones can download the app, but don't have to have constant internet connection. The students can download a course and work on the lessons while off-line. Once they come back into connection with the internet, their lessons are uploaded to their Study Helper. This mode of study is ideal for students in parts of the world with no or lagging postal systems, like Africa.

Is World Bible School still effective? One of our East Reach preachers, Anjel Banda, was converted by reading the World Bible School lessons his father received from former member Don Ellis. Recently, Chris Lana studied with a lady, Shena, from Colorado. During their study, Shena requested to be baptized. (This story was included in the November issue of Action!, World Bible School's bimonthly publication.)

Jimmie Lovell named this outreach "World Bible School" to reflect both the Great Commission and its fulfillment. Are you doing your part in carrying out the Great Commission? If you would like more information on how to get involved with the work Baker Heights is doing through World Bible School,
