BE QUICK TO LISTEN, SLOW TO SPEAK, SLOW TO BECOME ANGRY AND SLOW TO POST ON SOCIAL MEDIA

Something has been weighing heavy on my heart and I feel I need to say something. We live in a society where negativity is rampant and where belittling, bad mouthing and even slander has become the norm. Living in the age of digital communication and social media has made this kind of negativity even easier for us. We tend to say things on social media that we would never say to someone's face. We seem emboldened by the fact that if we can't see someone, or they can't see us, then it must be alright to say something negative about them. After all we may think, everyone else is saying the same thing! In 2020 with the polarization caused by differing political views, we reached new levels of negative, destructive, and even slanderous social media posts. Often, we find ourselves re-posting something negative that others have posted. By doing so, aren't we putting our name, and our stamp of approval on those things?

Where do we stand as Christ followers on the issue? Does our political stance make it "ok" to belittle others who see things differently? Does the new "norm" in our society make that "right" which has always been "wrong?"

I want to call on all of us to reevaluate the way we deal with other people. I want to remind us that of all the people on the planet, we should be examples of civility and love, of the positive, the joyous and the hopeful. Most of can remember a parent or grandparent telling us "if you can't say anything nice about someone, then don't say anything." I think that is very good advice for Christians and social media. Or better yet, the words of Paul in **Philippians 4:8**

"Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things."
Could we add: **"—post such things?"**

I would be the first to say that sometimes I do slip and say things about others that I later regret. Can we all just work together on being those who "build-up" instead of those who "tear-down"?
