GOOD MORNING

Before we left last Friday for our annual Big Bend trip, I got a call from Marty and Chris, two of our sponsors for the trip. They went down earlier to check out our campsite, since we were having to go to a new area due to COVID-19 restrictions. They reported back to me that we probably should not bring the trailer because the roads were just too rough. So that meant a crazy scramble to unload the trailer and slim down to just the essentials in order to fit it all in the van. I would like to say that I made all the right decisions. keeping what we needed and leaving what we did not, but that was not the case. This last week I often went looking for something, only to realize I left it behind, or came across something we could have easily done without.

Deciding what is really important and what you can't live without isn't a bad thing to do from time to time. I had a college professor who tried to put things in perspective for his students. He challenged his class saying, "If there was a fire approaching your house, and you knew that in 10 minutes everything was going to be lost, what would you try and save?" Those are the things that really matter to you and a reflection of what your priorities are. The questions for the students were always, "Are you happy with the things you saved," and "Where are your priorities?"

Jesus gave a similar warning and reflection to his listeners at the sermon on the mount. He said.

> Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroy, and where thieves do not break in or steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Matthew 6:19-21.

So, my challenge for you this morning is to look around your life. What are the things you could not live without? Are you happy with those priorities? Remember the words of "...where your treasure is, there your heart will be
