GOOD MORNING

When I go camping, one of the things I always try to remember to pack is a good multipurpose knife. I still remember the first pocket knife my dad gave me. It was a Swiss Army knife. I also remember some of the warnings and instructions he gave me when I got it. He told me a knife is dangerous, especially if you do not know how to use it probably and that a dull knife is more dangerous than a sharp one.

I read an article the other day comparing the word of God to a Swiss Army knife. The designer of the knife was Karl Elsener. He wanted to make a military knife that would leave someone fully equipped for survival. I have seen modern day versions of the Swiss Army knife that have everything from a sawblade to a magnifying glass. I've even seen one that had a writing pen in it. That may be overboard but when you are trying to survive in the wilderness you want to be fully equipped.

We need something to equip us to survive spiritually in this sinful world as well. God has given us His Word, a kind of spiritual knife for the soul. Paul writes:

> All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Tim. 3:16-17).

The article explained that the word translated "equipped" means to "furnish or fit completely." How does the Bible equip us for life's journey? It provides spiritual truth in doctrine; reproof in showing our imperfections; correction by revealing our sinful failures; and instruction in living a righteous life. There is not a more valuable tool than God's Word to make us fully equipped for spiritual survival and personal growth.

I will close with the same warnings my dad gave me when he presented me with my first knife. Let us make sure we know how to use it and remember to always keep it sharp.
