MEGAPHONE EVANGELISM OR "A STILL, SMALL VOICE?"

The Bible is full of examples of extroverted, outspoken people. God often chose such people for leadership roles or to be those who spoke for him. We may think of Joshua, Saul, David, Solomon, Peter, or the Apostle Paul. Thank God for such people who can speak about their faith in a public way! But it is obvious, that God did not wire us all the same way! Think about Moses, who was afraid to speak, or Jacob who was a "quiet man", or even our Lord Jesus who was described as the servant who **"will not quarrel or cry out, no one will hear his voice in the streets."** (Isa. 42:1-4)

I am drawn to the example of Andrew in the gospels. Being the brother of Peter, he likely didn't have much of a chance to speak out. Peter always seemed to be the one who had a quick response. It seems that Andrew didn't need to. When he found something special, something important, something life changing, he had to share it. And share it he did: not in the public square, but one on one with his brother. **(John 1:41)**

The fact is many of us are like Andrew: normal, quiet, honest folks. Few people really respond to flashy evangelistic methods. People respond to authentic, honest, caring people. If great, expensive programs were the "secret" to evangelism, then the people with the most money would be most successful at evangelizing. If big buildings were the secret, then Europe, with all its enormous cathedrals would be full of Christians! But at the end of the day, it boils down to relationships. It boils down to showing mercy and compassion to those around us. It boils down to sharing what is most important to us with those we know, and those with whom we come into contact. I guess the big question is: what **is** most important to you? The second question: who do you know that you can share it with?
