GOOD MORNING...

So, I try to keep in mind the lesson I learned from one of the first sermon examples I ever used, which I shared with you not too long ago. She had been doing this for some time when a man approached her and said, “Little girl, why are you doing this? Look at this beach! You can’t save all these starfish. You can’t begin to make a difference!”

The girl seemed crushed, suddenly deflated. But after a few moments, she bent down, picked up another starfish, and hurled it as far as she could into the ocean. Then she looked up at the man and replied, “Well, I made a difference to that one!”

The old man looked at the girl inquisitively and thought about what she had done and said. Inspired, he joined the little girl in throwing starfish back into the sea.

So, as we start to make plans of activities, events, and programs, let us not lose sight of the “small” opportunities right in front of us. Who is the person in your life you could reach out to, encourage, or teach about Christ? Let us all go out and make a difference, even if it means starting with just one.
