BE LIKE CHRIST - PHILIPPANS 2:1-11

How can the Church survive in the hostile world that we live in today? Paul gives us the answer in Philippians 2:1-11. The answer Paul gives is that we all strive to be like our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! How do we accomplish this overwhelming task? In verses 1-5, Paul states the core of the gospel reminding us of what we have already received from Christ: encouragement, comfort, fellowship with the Spirit, tenderness, and compassion. Afterwards he encourages us to live accordingly!

Then in verses 6-11, Paul shows us the sweet image of Jesus. Jesus could have demanded worship, but instead he chose to serve out of concern for others. Jesus had everything under his control. Yet he chose to give up everything to become a servant, and to die on the cross for us who are lost sinners without hope. Therefore, God exalted him above all else, and he alone is worthy of our praise and devotion. Paul makes the point that this is the way God wants us to live! God wants us to live like Christ!

To achieve such a lofty goal, we must start by doing the following:

- If we have received grace, we must show grace to others.
- If we want joy in our lives, we must become a servant to God and those around us.
- If we want peace in our lives, we must empty our lives of our selfish concerns and place others first.

Thus, we should remember this – being like Christ is a way of living, not just a sometimes thing we do one Sunday. It is a God-breathed Spirit that empowers us to live as Christ has shown us.

In John 1:14 we read that the “Word (Christ) became flesh.” That Word should shape our lives and the Church. We are all bound together by God through the life of Christ. He lived as a servant and so should we who wear his name. If we do this, we will not only survive in this world, but we will also grow his body, the Church!
