SUNDAY DINNER WITH **FRIENDS**

Growing up in a preacher's family, I remember how "sacred" those Sunday dinners were. Typically, there was fried chicken or a pot roast that had been left cooking while we were at the worship assembly. What a joy it was to walk through the front door and smell that pot roast! More often than not, we would have guests for lunch. That added a special dimension to the meal. The good food, the conversations at the table and even the cleaning up were all part of a special fellowship that bound us together as a church and as a family. Eating together with friends and family should be a special time.

In the last days of Jesus' life on earth, he shared at least a couple special meals with those who were close to him. We are all familiar with what we call the "last supper", the Passover meal that Jesus shared with his apostles. It was in the context of this meal that he shared with those closest to him the meal that would be eaten to remember his life, his death, and his resurrection. This is the meal we share each Sunday. In John 12, Jesus gathered for a meal. It was a meal with his disciples and with his special friends, Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. Yes, you heard it right. Lazarus is there! Just a few days previous he had been bound in grave clothes. He had been dead. He had been dead long enough that Martha objected to opening his grave. "But, Lord, by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days." Lazarus was dead but now he was sitting at the table sharing a meal with friends, sharing a meal with the "bread of life." The power that Jesus that Messiah had over death was no longer a question for some who had witnessed Lazarus walk out of that sealed grave. Can you imagine the scene? Can you imagine the celebration? Can you imagine the thoughts going through their heads as they contemplated the words of Jesus, that he, too, would die and be raised on the third day? What would you have asked Lazarus had you been invited to that meal? What would you have asked Jesus?
