GOOD MORNING

Last Sunday, for me, was what I have started to call a "Martha morning". So it was very fitting that the story of Mary and Martha was part of Larry's sermon. We were trying to get ready to leave for camp. I had couple of things I needed to do for the service, a last-minute announcement, some technical difficulties, and throw into the mix trying to potty train a two-year-old. By the time I sat down to worship, my mind was everywhere. Those were all good things, but it's easy to let good things sometime take us away from the reality of sitting amongst God's family and lifting our praise and worship to Him.

That is where the "Martha morning" comes in. In Luke chapter 10 we find the story of Mary and Martha. We are told Mary was sitting at Jesus' feet listening to his teaching, but Martha was distracted by the need to serve the guests. Martha became frustrated because she was taking care of all the cooking, cleaning, and other things by herself and she asks Jesus to tell Mary to help. But Jesus instead answered, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her." (Luke 10:42)

Martha's serving and taking care of things was not a bad thing, but she forgot why the people gathered there in the first place. They were there because of Jesus - who he was and what he had to say. Jesus' words remind us that our relationship with Him is more important than any activity or task that might temporarily capture our attention. Try as we hard as we might we will have those "Martha-like mornings" at times. But we need to be sure that we don't turn those into Martha lives, distracted by good things like work, hobbies, and even family. These are all good things and worth our time, but if we allow them to take the place of God in our lives, we are missing out on that which is better and will never be taken from us. So let us make sure this week, and for the rest of our lives, we spend some time at the feet of our master.
