I NEED A REST!

Reading through the sermon that we call "Hebrews", there is a word that keeps popping up. It is the word "rest." I know that when we (21st century American Christians) hear that word, each of us conjures up a different picture of what "rest" means to us. For some of us it is sitting in a camping chair on the banks of a river watching the fishing line as the sun rises. For others, it is sitting down to that cup of coffee or tea after finally getting the kids down for a nap. What does "rest" mean to you? After the 18 months that we have behind us. "rest" could mean just getting back to the way things used to be.

For the original readers of Hebrews, "rest" conjured up different ideas as well. For some it was the Sabbath day God had commanded them to keep as a day of rest. This day was based on God having "rested" after spending six days creating the world. For those Israelites standing on the banks of the Jordan, it was the promised land, a long awaited "rest" from their wilderness wanderings. But the Hebrew writer wants us to know that "God's rest", the rest he has prepared for his faithful, obedient people is so much more! For one thing, God's rest is an inner rest, an inner peace. It is a peace that enables us to come to rest in our hearts because we trust in God's ability to cleanse our hearts (1 John 3:19-21). But there is also a rest awaiting God's people that will allow them to "rest from their works" eternally. Now isn't that a wonderful thought? John said it this way:

"Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them." Revelation 14:13

I don't know about you, but I need a rest now and then. In the hustle and bustle of this world. I need to know that I can rest in God and in his promises! I need to maintain that living hope that there is an eternal rest waiting for me, and for all who have placed their trust in God!
