HAVE YOU SIGNED THE CHECK?

Ok, I can imagine where your mind might be going as you read those words. Maybe you are thinking: "Did I forget to pay a bill?" Better yet, maybe you are thinking: "yeah, that preacher is going to hit me up for an increase in my contribution!" No, I am talking about taking a blank check and signing your name at the bottom. Have you ever done that? It is, of course, an absurd thought, unless we are giving the check to someone in whom we have complete, unwavering trust . . . complete, unwavering trust.

What about signing such a check and giving it to God? You see, climbing on the altar, offering ourselves willingly to God as living sacrifices (Rom. 12:1) is like that isn't it? It is like saying "Father, for what it is worth, I am turning everything over to you." I love the words to this contemporary song:

"I'm yours, Lord, everything I am, everything I'm not. I'm yours, Lord, try me now and see. See if I can be completely yours."

Giving God a blank check...or as one author described it, sliding a signed, blank check under the door to the throne room of the Almighty, involves exhibiting a complete, undiluted trust in God. It is allowing Him to do with my life as he sees fit. But what if he fills in a bigger sum than I have? What if he demands more of me than I am capable of giving? Really? Trusting God means, among other things, trusting him to use me, use my potential, and yes even to use my weaknesses in ways that will bring him honor, and will help his kingdom to grow.

Do you remember the words of Christ in the garden; "not my will, but your will be done?" When we are willing to hand all over to God, to do with as he chooses, we reflect the heart of Christ!
