GOOD MORNING

This morning, I thought I would share the article as well as the direction of my sermon I planned to give before I got sick. A devotional I was reading the other day focused on a quote from Mark Twain. He is credited with saying, "When I was a boy of 14, my father was so ignorant I could hardly stand to have the old man around. But when I got to be 21, I was astonished at how much the old man had learned in 7 years." I have never thought of my father as ignorant or not wanted him around, but as I have gotten older I have appreciated him and his wisdom more and more.

There are some young people who show little respect for their fathers and mothers. As they mature, many begin to recognize that Mom and Dad knew a lot more than they gave them credit for. Our perspective and appreciation change as we get older. But there are still many who don't come to accept and appreciate the counsel of their parents until it is too late.

The Bible says, "**Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 'Honor your father and mother,' which is the first commandment with promise: 'that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth' (Ephesians 6:1-3).** The book of Proverbs says, "**Listen to your father who gave you life . . . The father of the righteous will greatly rejoice, and he who fathers a wise child will be glad in him.**" (Proverbs 23:22,24)

I know no father or parent is perfect, but it will serve us all well to remember to honor them and extend the same grace unto them that we desire. Let us not get caught up on finding fault or dwell on ways we don't see eye to eye. Instead let us focus on the wisdom, counsel, and good things they have bestowed upon us. Let us not just today, but always, find ways to honor our fathers. Even if for no other reason than because our heavenly Father has instructed us to.
