THE WORD OF GOD IS NOT BOUND!

The last 18 months or more have been challenging for all of us. Struggling through the pandemic, locked down, not able to meet together, watching as dear brothers and sisters passed on, and worshipping from home, have all been troubling and discouraging for us. I missed being together with my church family and I know most of us felt the same way. It often felt like the word of God was "put on hold." Surely mission work could not function as it had and surely outreach was at a standstill, wasn't it? I was encouraged by the words of Rusty Brown last Wednesday evening as he showed the way that God had worked even during the time of the severe pandemic. I was reminded again of the words of Paul to Timothy in **2 Timothy 2:9, "the word of God is not bound."**

Locked up in prison, expecting that his time on this earth was almost over, sure that his preaching days were passed, Paul stressed to Timothy that even though he may have lost his freedom, **"the word of God is not bound."**

But even when the preacher is silenced, God's word continues to spread. The more you try to stop it, the more it seems to do its work. Centuries later, after many attempts to stop it, God's word still continues to capture new hearts.

You can lock up the preacher, whether by prison or by social distancing, but you can never lock up God's word. It always runs free. As God made clear in Isaiah 55, his word will always accomplish what he intends it to. **"... so is my word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." (Isaiah 55:11)**

The word cannot be chained. The word cannot be put under quarantine. Long after we are gone, that word will continue to do what God intends, to his glory and to the salvation of men and women.
