WHAT DO YOU SEE?

It took place in Lake Arthur, New Mexico, a small community south of Roswell in October of 1977. Maria Rubio was rolling up a burrito for her husband's breakfast when she noticed something unusual. She noticed that there was a thumb-sized burn mark from the skillet on one side of the tortilla. The mark resembled the face of Jesus, or at least what Maria thought the face of Jesus would look like. It goes without saving that her husband went without breakfast that morning. Maria ran through the town to show the neighbors the miraculous sign. After the local priest blessed the tortilla, she brought it home. put it in a glass box and surrounded it with cotton batting to make it look like it was floating. She built a shrine for it so others could come and visit. In the next months, more than 8000 people visited the so-called Shrine of Jesus, the tortilla.

Well, I know most of you are holding back a smirk as you read this, but this is really no laughing matter, is it? It is so easy for us to be mixed up about who Jesus really is. The author of Hebrews goes to great ends to show the ancient readers, and to remind us modern readers, that Jesus is not just a cute little baby in a manger or a humiliated man suffering on a Roman cross. God raised Him from the dead. exalted Him to his right hand where he reigns supreme. He is not simply a prophet, weakened by humanity, nor an angel limited by the hand of mighty God. He is the Son. He is divine. He is the creator and sustainer of creation. He is the provider of salvation for all who will believe and obey him. What do you see in this Jesus?
