REFLECTIONS OF A **EUROPEAN WANDERER**

It is great to be back with the Baker Heights family after being gone for almost five weeks. I spent the first two weeks of my trip without Pam, helping some of the churches in Vienna. As I have shared before, the work with refugees has blossomed in Austria, with many Muslims coming to know Jesus for who he really is, the Savior of their souls. I was able to teach and preach as well as do personal counseling while there. After two weeks, I traveled by train to Prague, where I met my son who drove down from his home in Leipzig to meet me. From there we drove to Leipzig together. I was able to spend some quality time with him, and even worked for him a couple of days. Pam joined me in Leipzig a few days later.

We shared a couple of great weeks visiting churches in the cities of Chemnitz and Leipzig. We were able to reconnect with Christian family in both cities, and with our son in Leipzig. We were enriched and encouraged by what we saw in both places. We have shared the faith journeys of most all of the members in the Chemnitz congregation. Many are still there from when the congregation was established back at the beginning of the 90s. Now many of their children are members of the church as well. We shared life with these people for 24 years, experiencing new births in Christ, marriages, the birth of their children and deaths of many of our members. We share so many meaningful memories! I hope that you will be with us this morning, as I give a short report of our trip and share with you all what is going on in the refugee outreach in Vienna and the former East German congregations.
