GOOD MORNING!

Our society has been dealing with a rise in depression and mental health issues over the last couple of years. The pandemic may have made things worse, but often the root cause is a poor self-image. I was recently reminded of some research I wrote about a few years back. Psychological studies have established that a child has developed a fairly definite impression of themselves by age five. The same studies indicate that self-esteem is not closely related to social position, family work background, education, or any combination of such factors. The studies show that a young child sees himself from the reflections of those close to him – mainly his parents. How they react to his/her activities largely determines the self-image the child builds.

I wish the same would be true for us in a spiritual sense. I wish our self-image would come from our spiritual parent. But too often we allow the world to control who we are and how we see ourselves. Maybe it really does boil down to who we are closest to. If you are closest to the world then you take your self-image from it. The world says that our self-image should be based on our own skills, accomplishments, status, financial resources, or appearance. And – if you are like me – sometimes those things let you down. But as Christians, our identity should come from God and Christ. Listen to some of what the Bible says about us: “are fearfully and wonderfully made,” “God chose His children,” “we are God’s own possession.” The world tells us our worth comes from what we can do, but God says our self-worth comes from who made us. We are told that God valued us so much that even while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

So, let us ignore what the world says and pay attention to what the One who made us has to say about who we are and how we should see ourselves.
