TAKES A LICKING AND KEEPS ON TICKING

It was back in the 1960s when television was still a novelty and TV commercials were still in the prehistoric era, that the Timex watch company found an effective way to advertise. In numerous commercial tests, the Timex company would strap one of their watches to a boat propeller, to an ice skater's skate, or to the hand of a world champion cliff diver. All this to show that their watches were sturdy and worth the \$9.95 you paid for one. Their motto was, "Takes a licking and keeps on ticking." This motto would fit very well into our study of the Hebrew sermon.

Those Christians who heard that sermon for the first knew what it was to suffer. **"Remember the earlier days after you received the light, when you endured a great conflict full of suffering."** (10:32) The writer encourages them not to "shrink back" in their faith, not to give up, but to hold on to their confidence and faith! The fact is, our faith will be tested...maybe not on the propeller of a motorboat, but maybe in the fires of temptation or suffering, maybe in the storms of disappointment and doubt.

The words of the writer in **Heb. 10:39** ring out encouragement, **"But we do not belong to those who shrink back and are destroyed, but to those who have faith and are saved."** The eleventh chapter will give us a long list of those who have been tested and have come out winners. Can we stand firm under testing and trial? Can we show what our faith is really made of, as did so many believers before us?
