GOOD MORNING

I was having a conversation with someone the other day about whether it was appropriate to focus on the birth of Jesus this time of year. We know that most scholars don't think he has born on the 25th or even this time of year. It is most likely that they took the celebration of the winter solstice that was already going on and tried to center it around Christ. I personally don't think it's right or wrong if you take time to remember Christ's birth at this time of year and I think it is a beautiful thing that on Christmas day millions, if not billions, of people will be thinking about Christ. I do think it is important that we don't let his birth get caught up in the myth that sometimes surrounds Christmas. It is not just a story for children or subject matter for Christmas chorales. It is a true event when mankind was given the greatest gift the world has ever known. I am reminded of a poem by Joseph Bayly-

> Praise Him for the incarnation. for the word made flesh. I will not sing of shepherds watching flocks on frosty nights, or angel choristers. I will not sing of a stable bare in Bethlehem, or lowing oxen. wise men trailing star with gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Tonight I will sing praise to the Father who stood on heaven's threshold and said farewell to his Son as he stepped across the stars to Bethlehem and Jerusalem. And I will sing praise to the infinite, eternal Son, who became most finite, a baby who in the heavens, Praise him in the stable. Praise him in my heart.

So whether it is this time of year or not let us always remember the true events of Jesus birth.
