## WHERE SELDOM IS HEARD, AN ENCOURAGING WORD

When we travel in Europe. Pam and I often traveled using public transportation. I often found myself watching other people, wondering what they were thinking and where they were in their lives. There are unwritten rules in Europe for riding on the streetcar, bus, or train. You don't smile because people might think you want something. You don't speak to others because it is a sign of weakness or worse. And you never sit next to someone you don't know if there is another seat available. It seems that we are programmed for isolation and loneliness. We don't want strangers invading our space.

I remember sitting behind a young man who was traveling with his 6-year-old daughter. They carried on an intelligent conversation for several minutes before I got up the courage to say something to them. His side of the conversation showed love, concern, and genuine respect for her. He met her where she was, talked to her on her level. I was so impressed that I had to break the infamous "public transportation rules". I told him how impressed I was to see how he communicated with his daughter, how he did not speak down to her, but listened with genuine interest and met her on her level. I will never forget how his face beamed.

It can often be so simple to say an encouraging word that can change the course of the day! Can we learn to be better listeners and speak only when we have something encouraging to say? Can we make it our goal in the coming year to have our ears open to those around us and our hearts attuned to the needs of others?
