GOOD MORNING

How are your New Years' resolutions going, if you decided to make any at all this year? Have you started them yet? Have you started one but already forgot it? Often, we make vows to change at the start of a new month, new year, change of season, or a major birthday. I was reading that this is such a common thing among people that researchers have a name for it: the fresh start effect. They suggest that at calendar points like these, we're more prone to assess our lives and try putting our failures behind us, or to start over. Wanting to be better people, we long for a fresh start.

As Christians, we meet together at the beginning of each week and remember and honor the event that continues to give us a fresh new start. Christ's death did not just make that possible the first time you decided to become a Christian, but each day of our lives. In fact Paul tells us, in Philippians 3, that he had not yet fully achieved his goal of being completely like Christ. But one thing he had taken hold of, was "Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead." He goes on to say that "All of us, then, who are mature should take such a view of things."

So, as we remember and celebrate the death of Christ this morning, let us always remember the fresh new start we continue to have through him. Forgetting what is behind and pressing on towards our goal to like him.

¹²Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.

¹³Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do:

Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, ¹⁴I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus. ¹⁵All of us, then, who are mature should take such a view of things. And if on some point you think differently that too God will make clear to you. ¹⁶Only let us live up to what we have already attained.
