GOOD MORNING

One of my favorite things to do is to take little gifts to my wife during the workday. It might be flowers, lunch, or candy - just something to let her know I am thinking about her. Before COVID it was simple: I would just walk in and leave it in the office, and they would let her pick it up there. But when COVID hit, everything changed. First, it started out where you couldn't even enter the school - I had to label the gift and leave it outside the door, hoping it found its way to her. Later, they would let you in; but you had to show your ID, go through a small medical exam and sign a wavier of some type.

Even though it was difficult to enter a school during the height of COVID... in Old Testament times it was much more difficult and restrictive to enter the Holy of Holies. This was the most sacred place in the tabernacle and temple. There was a curtain which separated the Holy Place from the Holy of Holies and only the high priest was allowed to enter there. Even then, he was only allowed to enter once a year. Before he entered, he had to bring a special offering, bathe, and wear sacred garments. God's rules for entering were not for health or security reasons. They were there to teach the Israelites about the holiness of God and man's need for forgiveness.

Something we probably do not talk enough about is, that at Jesus' death, that special curtain separating the Holy of Holies was torn. That torn curtain symbolically showed all people who believed and accepted Jesus' sacrifice, that their sins were forgiven. Now, with Jesus as the new high priest, they could approach God. So, let's not forget the amazing things Jesus did for us through his death on the Cross.
