“... YOU WILL BE BLESSED IF YOU DO THEM.”

We hear it a lot these days, “have a blessed day!” Sometimes we use it as a way to end letters or telephone conversations. “How are you?” we often ask and often we hear “blessed” as an answer. The idea of being “blessed” can conjure up thoughts of physical blessings or pleasant circumstances in life. We read the word “Makarios,” the word most often translated “blessed” in the New Testament, over 50 times. Basically, the word refers to “the transcendent happiness of a life beyond care, labor and death. “Other definitions add: “being joyful, content, happy or gratified in your situation.” Reading John 13 in the past weeks, I was struck by verse 17. After Jesus had admonished the disciples to wash one another’s feet he added. “Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them.” He certainly does not mean that we will be physically or materially better off if we “do these things.” He is not urging us to serve others so that we might somehow “earn our blessedness.” He is letting us know that we will find true contentment, gratitude, and even joy in “doing these things.” It is true, that the greatest joys in life, the greatest contentment, the most fulfilling gratitude that we can experience is not when people are serving us, filling our bank account, or praising us for who we are or what we have done. True contentment and joy, true blessedness, Jesus tells us comes from serving people and seeing their needs met.
