Recently, I received an email from an old friend. While in college, he and I sang together in a group representing the school. My friend sent me a link to a video of a song that we used to open our program each time we performed. It was called "Song for Judith". We knew it as "Open the door". When I heard the song again after so many years, I was surprised by its relevance to our times. The lyrics speak of the values of friendship and the importance of opening the door to those around us. Let's face it: Loneliness is a huge problem in our world. Surrounded by seven billion other people, we manage to box ourselves into our little worlds.
