GOOD MORNING

We just finished our study on the book of Matthew in the youth class. As we recapped the stories of Christ, I was reminded of story I shared several years ago. The Navy SEALs were performing a covert operation to rescue some hostages. The team flew in by helicopter, made their way to the compound and stormed into the room where the hostages had been imprisoned for months. The room was dark and filthy, and the hostages were curled up in a corner, terrified. The SEALs stood at the door calling to the hostages telling them that they were Americans and were here to rescue them. The hostages sat there hiding their eyes in fear. They were not of healthy mind and did not believe that their rescuers were really Americans.

The SEALs stood there, not knowing what to do. There was no way they could carry all the hostages out. One of the SEALs had an idea. He put down his gun, took off his gear and curled up next to the hostages. He softened his face and put his arms around them. He was trying to show them that he was one of them. None of the prison guards would have done this. The Navy SEAL stayed there for a little while until some of the hostages started to look at him. Then he gently whispered that they were Americans and were there to rescue them. He asked them if they would follow them to safety. One by one the prisoners stood up and began to follow their rescuers.

This is like what Christ did for us. He left his place in heaven and humbled himself. He became a man so that he might live among us. He did this so that we might see Him, know Him, and follow Him. And if that wasn't enough, He even died on the cross so that we might live with Him eternally. So, let's remember Jesus this morning and thank God daily for the friend we have in Jesus.
