GOOD MORNING

Several are missing this Sunday morning because we are on our annual Big Bend National Park trip. This year, for our devotional times, I decide to center our talks around the different wildlife that we might see. We will look at Bible stories that talk about things like lions, pigs, snakes, falcons, and even scorpions. But this morning we are going to talk about bears. Yes, there are bears at Big Bend, and there are a few things you need to know if you run into a bear. Here is what the experienced hikers who know the habits of bears say:

- Don't run. Bears can run faster.
- Don't climb a tree. Bears climb.
- If the bear is a grizzly, curl up and play dead. If it's black, move wildly and make lots of noise.
- Never, never offer food to a bear.
- Never underestimate a bear.
- Above all, don't get between a mother bear and her cubs.

A bear separated from her cubs will destroy anything that gets in her way while trying to get back to them. In Hosea 13:8, God's anger towards Israel's disobedience is described like a bear being separated from her cubs. If you ever want to know how seriously God takes disobedience, just read Hosea 13. But, in the same way, if you want to know about God's love and forgiveness, just continue reading through chapter 14. In that chapter, the text says if they repent, God will "heal their waywardness and love them freely." So, let us never underestimate how seriously God takes disobedience, and when we discover we have fallen away, let us return to His loving arms.
