# THE BLESSINGS OF A POSITIVE **ATTITUDE**

Nothing can contribute more to the quality of our lives than a positive attitude. And yet, sometimes it is easy for us to become critical. We end up focusing on the negatives.

**Pay attention** - I speak not of looking through rose-colored glasses and deciding that everything is just fine and dandy. Yes, there are people who find something good in almost every situation, no matter how negative it might be.

If you look hard enough, you can find something positive in almost everything. But I'm not talking about that kind of Pollyanna attitude. Rather, it's about being realistic, realizing that in the midst of all the negatives there is still much good in the world, in the church, and in our lives. Focus our attention and energy on what is good.

> "Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things." Philippians 4:8

Now that's positive!

"As a man thinks in his heart, so is he" (Proverbs 23:7 KJV). The things that dominate your thinking control the words you speak, the attitudes you have, and the way you react to others.

Christians have every reason to be joyful and positive - because we're moving toward something better and greater and higher. We will have a reunion with our Lord, and we'll be with Him for all eternity. We have every reason to be joyful.

In 1 Thessalonians 5:2, Paul says, "Okay, here we are, waiting for the Lord to come." In the meantime, as we wait, how can we develop this positive spirit? Practical suggestions:

- Develop a positive spirit by having a positive attitude toward our spiritual leaders (5:12-13).
- Have a positive attitude toward other believers (5:14-15)
- "Be joyful always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances" (5:16-18)

"...in all circumstances" - that's tough! Regardless of what's happening in our lives, we're to be joyful, pray, and give thanks! May God help us to be such!
