GIVING AWAY YOUR HOUSE KEYS

During my recent trip to Germany, I was amazed by the level of hospitality and by the willingness to help, which is being shown by so many European countries. Not only are these countries providing humanitarian aid to millions of Ukrainians forced to flee their country, but thousands of people are also opening their homes to "strangers." They are literally handing over the keys to their apartments to people they have never met. I met one single mother who has invited two displaced Ukrainian women into her home. What a beautiful display of basic hospitality!

Now, I am not advocating swapping house keys with someone else, nor am I advocating giving over our homes to people we don't know, though the opportunity may arise in the future. I am talking about a willingness to hand over a different set of "keys", the keys or the access to our hearts and our lives. We are by culture, very open and ready to talk about anything with anybody. But after a certain point, that "openness" tends to shut down. The transparency of the Apostle Paul's life and work was one of the keys to his success as an evangelist, missionary and servant of God. In **Acts 20** Paul says to the elders of the Ephesian church; **"You know how I lived the whole time I was with you . . ."** (v. 18), and **"you yourselves know that these hands of mine have supplied my own needs and the needs of my companions"** (v. 34). Paul's life was an open book. Paul practiced "transparent integrity." The way he lived in the public eye was in sync with his private life. He was open, transparent, and authentic.

That could be a scary thought for some of but sharing our lives and our hearts with others also opens the door to deeper relationships and to opportunities for sharing the good news of Jesus. "Authenticity" is the buzzword of this generation. The fact is, a humble, authentic Christian man or woman, living out his Christian faith daily, will be much more effective, and will show Christ more clearly than a polished expert with all the right answers. I guess that old adage continues to ring true; "I'd rather see a sermon than hear one any day."
