COME AND GONE

Easter has come and gone.... Or has it?? Is Easter just once a year? What do you think? Oh, for sure, hunting easter eggs is a once-a-year thing... thank goodness! Sugar-highs are crazy, huh?

But Easter The celebration of the resurrection of Jesus... is that, for us, just a once-a-year thing? I hope not. We lay claim to the belief that we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus EVERY Lord's Day. But do we really?

The same power that raised Jesus from the dead can give sinners a new life. The new life begins with baptism into the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ. (Romans 6:3-7) Our greatest privilege is to be buried by baptism with Christ and into Christ!
