GOOD MORNING,

Most of our area is under what the government labels as a severe drought and some parts are even labeled as extreme. I don't have to tell you that this last week has been abnormally hot, which make the problems of lack of rainfall even worse. Every time there is a drought in our state, farmers start to worry about their crops and ranchers become concerned about feed and fires. The only way farmers and ranchers survive these dry times is by not relying solely on the water that comes from the sky, but also relying on the water that comes from the ground. During these dry times they use streams, rivers, and wells in order to keep their crops and animals alive. And they just hope and pray that the drought never gets so bad that those dry up as well.

As Christians, we are told how we are supposed to survive the dry time in our lives. When things in our lives get hard and troublesome, we are to trust in God. In Jeremiah 17:7-8 it reads.

> Blessed are those who trust in the LORD. whose trust is the LORD. They shall be like a tree planted by water, sending out its roots by the stream. It shall not fear when heat comes, and its leaves shall stay green; in the year of drought it is not anxious, and it does not cease to bear fruit.

If we trust in the Lord when the hard times come. we will be ok. It says that our leaves will be green. and we will continue to bear fruit. We know that no matter how hot and dry it gets, God will always be there. So let us be like a tree planted by the water - trusting in and relying on our God.
