GOOD MORNING,

Most of our area is under what the government labels as a severe drought and some parts are even labeled as extreme. I don't have to tell you that this last week has been abnormally hot, which make the problems of lack of rainfall even worse. Every time there is a drought in our state, farmers start to worry about their crops and ranchers become concerned about feed and fires. If we trust in the Lord when the hard times come, we will be ok. It says that our leaves will be green, and we will continue to bear fruit. We know that no matter how hot and dry it gets, God will always be there. So let us be like a tree planted by the water – trusting in and relying on our God.
