WE'RE GLAD TO BE BACK...

We are glad to be back in this fellowship after having spent four weeks in Austria and Germany! It is always a joy to be reunited with those in Austria and Germany that we have worked with through the past decades! My time in Austria started well! I was able to help the Farci speaking congregation prepare and carry out a special get-together for a large group of Ukrainian refugees who are in a refugee camp an hour north of Vienna. The Farci speaking brethren planned and carried out the operation. I was merely a helper. There were around 50-60 present. One of the African sisters had prepared food for the group, the rest had gathered gifts for the children, and bags full of things for the mothers. Reggie Hiller, one of the church workers in Vienna, gave out the gifts, and formed a special bond with several of the Ukrainian ladies. She continues to travel there as she can, to meet with them. I drove a car with three young people from Vienna, and a back end full of potatoes and carrots.

It was later that night that I really started feeling poorly and decided to test for Covid. I tested positive. The next morning, I shuffled to a center where I could get an official test. I tested positive there as well. The next week was spend huddling in my bed with fever, chills, upset stomach, headache and all the other accompanying symptoms. I was able to get out and mingle the last couple days of my trip there. I worshipped with the African congregation Sunday morning, and then got on a train to Prague.

Kris, my son, met me in Prague, where we stayed in the oldest monastery in CZ, founded before 1000 AD. (of course it has been renovated a few times). We spent one day in the city wandering around before leaving for Leipzig on Tuesday morning. I met Pam at the train station on Tuesday afternoon, and we made our way to our hotel. We were able to spend a couple of days with Kris before Thursday, when Pam started feeling bad. She went downhill quickly. A day or so later, I followed with the same symptoms I had with Covid. We tested negative several times but became very sick. Our time in Leipzig was limited to remaining in bed. I was able to get out some as I got to feeling better and I was able to assemble with the Chemnitz congregation the Sunday before we left.

Since arriving back in Abilene, we have been trying to get our strength back. We are so very thankful for all the prayers, cards, and meals that you have given to help us back to strength! God is good! God's family is good! Thank you, Baker Heights family!
