This last month we have done a lot of driving back and forth from our house to camp. Every time, I couldn't help but think about our theme for our camp curriculum this year, "Traveling Home." We spent the first part of each week talking about how our citizenship is in heaven and we are just sojourners or aliens here.

The monkey will continue to pull and pull not realizing the orange won't fit the hole. While the monkey struggles with the orange, the hunters simply stroll in and capture the monkey by throwing a net over him. As long as the monkey keeps his fist wrapped around the orange, the monkey is trapped. All the monkey would have to do to be free is let go of the orange, but it's not willing to do it. Although many things in this world are nice, they are not our home. Just like the monkey we need to make sure we aren't holding on so tightly that we become trapped.
