“AND WE ARE HIS HOUSE . . .”

For some it is no more than four walls, a roof, and a door. For others, it is a dwelling place. It is a place, a space where we live, but for many it is much more than that. It is a space where we nurture those things that make a home. A house should be a place that invites, that welcomes, that embraces and that loves those who enter through those doors. It should be a space where a family shares peace, fellowship, renewal, comfort and care, communication, and encouragement. It should be a space for sharing fun times, for enjoying guests, for planning, for learning and for growing together.

The Hebrew writer probably shocked the original readers when he said in **3:6 “... and we are his house . . .”** We are the house of God. No, I don't mean the four walls a roof and a room full of pews! He is talking about a family. He is talking about brothers and sisters, which are the household of God. Paul called it **“God's household, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth.” (1 Tim. 3:15)** This household, the Hebrew writer goes on to say, should be a place where we hold firmly to confidence and hope. Moving forward and growing forward as the family of God we can encourage one another and in doing so, we build each other's confidence, and we strengthen our hope. In all of that we bring honor and glory to Jesus, the builder of the house!
