WHAT KIND OF LEGACY?

A few years back, while we were still living in Germany, we received news that my uncle Floyd had passed away. I would not typically fly back to the States for a funeral, but in this case, it was very important for me to be there. I had heard the phrase "my rich uncle in America" for many years while living in Germany. It came to be a kind of humorous dream for Germans: opening a letter, getting a phone call and receiving the news that our "rich uncle in America" had died and left us his fortune. It sounds like a great story, doesn't it? When my uncle Floyd passed, I already knew that I was an heir to his fortune. Now don't get me wrong, and please don't ask me for a loan! My uncle was never "rich" in the way the world sees wealth. I did not inherit one cent. But he was rich just the same. And the inheritance that he left me is worth more to me than all the money on the planet! You see, my uncle Floyd was a mentor, an example, a role model, a pioneer of sorts, and a good friend. He was a man with a deep faith in Jesus, a faith that he was not afraid to live out daily nor to share whenever he had the chance. For nearly 60 years he had worked to help orphan children to be able to lead "normal", happy lives. He was a church elder, a servant, a father, grandfather, uncle, friend and Christian brother. He left a legacy behind that is worth far more than Gold.

Have vou ever thought about it? I mean, have you ever thought about the kind of legacy you will leave behind? Have you ever thought about the words that would be spoken at your funeral? I am not trying to be morbid. We make a lot of preparations for "that day" when we pass from this life. We have our funds, our futures, our homes and property, but what kind of spiritual legacy will be there for our children, or for the next generation of Christians who surround us now while we are still living?
