THE FAMILY OF GOD

I'm going to borrow a favorite saying from Charles Goodnight, and say "Isn't it great to be a Christian?"

I think we all automatically answer "yes" to the question, but how often do we sit down and ponder the many ways that we are blessed? A lot of families have a so-called "black sheep", the one who marches to a different beat from the family, the one who has made some mistake in the past that has caused the family to be ashamed of them, and desires to sort of distance themselves from the reality of their shared family background.

Praise be to God that it is not that way in the family of God! Though he has every reason to be ashamed of us because of our sin, He is gracious and forgiving to us. As is written in **Hebrews 2:10-11**:

"For it was fitting that he for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering. For he who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one source. That is why he is not ashamed to call them brothers".

Jesus is not ashamed of us! The one who was a part of all creation, the one who had glory in heaven, came down and suffered at the hands of men, yet calls us his family. That seems to me to be part of the unfathomable riches of God.

So, with this in mind let me finish with the words of Paul in **Ephesians 2:19-22**:

"So, then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place or God by the Spirit."

We, the church, each one of us is a work-in-progress for the glory of God. Brothers and sisters, let us love one another as we work together for the Lord and look forward to his return.
