ARE YOU READY?

2 Corinthians 6:2

Years ago, when I was preaching in Houston, our worship song director always led the hymn – “Ready to suffer grief or pain, ready to stand the test...” At times, it was rather disconcerting... hoping too many didn’t suffer from my sermons. Ha! But it gets me to thinking... thinking about our readiness... our preparedness, even. The Boy Scouts motto reminds us to “BE PREPARED”. In fact, the founder of Boy Scouts defined being prepared as “always in a state of mind and body to do your duty”. I WONDER – are we, as God’s people, always in a state of mind to carry out our responsibilities in the Kingdom?!

We are called to be faithful to God and obey Him. Understand that there will be no second chances when the Lord returns. None. Oh, I think we all know what it is like to be prepared for something. If you have ever gone on a trip, you prepared first. Before you got married, you prepared for weeks and months. But the most important thing we can do is prepare for Christ’s return.
