GOOD MORNING

I missed out on our Find a Buddy fellowship last Sunday night because I was sick. Having friends that share our faith is such a blessing and we should all strive to reach out to each other and make those types of relationships. In Luke chapter 5 there is story about faith in friendship. Jesus had been teaching and healing the sick; people were coming from all around to see him. Some men had heard about these things and decided to bring their paralyzed friend to see Jesus. They used a mat as a stretcher and made their way to the house where Jesus was teaching. When they arrived, the crowds were so great they couldn't get to the front of the house - let alone through the door. Although most likely disheartened. the men – because of their love for their paralyzed friend and their faith in the healing power of Jesus – did not give up. They made their way to the roof of the house and dug a hole there in order to lower their friend into the crowd right in front of Jesus. Their love, friendship, and faith made them go to great lengths in order to give their friend the opportunity to be healed. Their friend was healed, and the people were amazed and praised God.

How many of us have friends who are suffering from much more than being paralyzed? How many of us have friends who are dying in their sins? These men did not let crowds, or any other difficulty keep them from bringing their friend to Jesus. Should we let fear, awkwardness, or the possibility of rejection keep us from introducing our friends to the One that heals? We could learn from the love, faith and willingness to do whatever it takes to help their friend that these men had. So let us value the people in our lives so much that we would be willing to dig through a roof for them.
