JOY TO THE WORLD!

Joy to the world, the Lord is come - Let earth receive her King.

Let every heart prepare Him room - And Heaven and Nature sina!

As we all know, today is the day that the vast majority of the world celebrates the birth of Jesus. This hymn is very popular at this time of the year... however, if you notice the words carefully, it is not so much about the incarnation of Jesus as it is the second coming of Jesus. "The Lord IS come", not the Lord has come. The first time Christ came. the world did not receive Him, rather, the world rejected Him, and hung Him on a cross. Read Isa. 53:3 - "He was despised and rejected by mankind; a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their face; he was despised, and we held him in low esteem."

Stanza 3 talks about sins and sorrows being no more: "No more let sins and sorrows grow, Nor thorns infest the ground; He comes to make his blessings flow, Far as the **curse is found.**" The world is not sin-free. The world is not void of sorrow. WE should not be alarmed at this world's brokenness. But we surely rejoice that Christ came to take away the brokenness.

The fields, floods, rock, hills, and plains continually repeat the sounding joy of the gospel, the glorious birth, life, death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. May we never stop repeating that Joy! May we ever hold His banner high! May we never forget that the greatest gift of God is the marvelous, amazing grace of Jesus Christ. To Him be glory forever and ever!
